## **Publication Policy**

Sefer expects its editors, authors, and reviewers to respect the following principles. Any manuscript that is found not in compliance with these principles may be rejected from publication.

- 1. The work submitted for publication by Sefer is an original piece of research;
- 2. The work has not been previously published. Any form of plagiarism is unacceptable. Self-plagiarism, i.e., the attempt to republish one's own previously published work without significant changes to it, is similarly unacceptable;
- 3. The authors will refrain from submitting the work for publication elsewhere while it is reviewed by Sefer, and following a positive outcome of the review process;
- 4. All sources in the manuscript must be properly cited and referenced
- 5. Sefer Editorial Board will evaluate submitted manuscripts solely on their intellectual merits
- 6. Each editor will report to the Editorial Board any conflicts of interest and respect the decision of the Board;
- 7. All submissions undergo a double-blind peer review process;
- 8. When two reviewers have been submitted their evaluations, Editorial Board will examine the reviews and decide regarding the submission. Occasionally, a decision is made based on more than two reviews, or a single review, which can be a review by the subject editor
- A reviewer will evaluate the submitted manuscript solely basing on the criteria outlined in the peer review form. A reviewer should notify the editors of any potential conflicts of interest
- 10. A reviewer will maintain strict confidentiality in matters pertaining to the review process
- 11. Each reviewer will notify the editors of any potential reason for rejecting the manuscript
